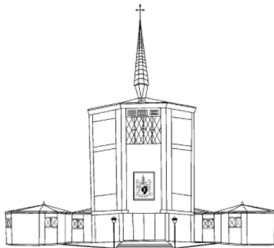

### FEAST DAYS DURING WEEK Cont'd

**Friday 7 July - St Maelruain bishop and abbot** founded the a monastery of Tallaght, Co Dublin.  
**Saturday 8 July - St Killian** - was born in the parish of Mullagh in the diocese of Kilmore. With 11 companions he left Ireland and became known as the apostle of Thuringia and eastern Franconia. He was put to death in 689 with Kolonat and Totnan. There is a very strong devotion to him in Wurzburg where his remains lie and also through the Bavarian countryside.

### NEW DEBIT CARD/CREDIT CARD MACHINE FACILITY

For parishioners/visitors who wish to donate to our parish (Saint Paul's, Lurgan) by using their debit card or visa card, please follow the instructions below:

- Select the amount you would like to donate to your parish.
- Simply tap the machine to make a contactless donation (not the screen) or alternatively you can insert your card into the machine with your pin.
- Select the button 'Yes' or 'No' which asks you if you wish to Gift Aid your donation. **Please note that if you wish to Gift Aid your donation you will need your type in your personal details.**
- Your transaction will be confirmed on the keypad and the screen will return to normal.

### FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

**Monday 3 July - St Thomas, Apostle** - is said to have preached the gospel in India where he was martyred. The faithful that led him to know Christ in his wounds also sent him to the farthest places to preach Christ.

#### Tuesday 4 July - St Elizabeth of Portugal

1271-1336, of the House of Aragon, had an unhappy marriage with the King of Portugal. She persevered in prayer and good works and as a widow lived in poverty as a Franciscan tertiary.

#### Wednesday 5 July - St Anthony Zaccaria, Priest

1502-39, was a medical doctor before becoming a priest in Milan, he founded the Barnabites.

#### Thursday 6 July - St Maria Goretti, Virgin and Martyr

1890-1902, stabbed to death in defence of her virtue and St **Moninne of Killeavy, Virgin** was one of Ireland's early female saints. After instruction in the religious life, she founded a community, initially consisting of eight virgins and a widow with a baby, at Slieve Gullion, in what became County Armagh. They lived an eremitical life. She died in 517.
