Saturday 8 July - St Killian - was born in the parish of Mullagh in the diocese of Kilmore. With 11 companions he left Ireland and became known as the apostle of Thuringia and eastern Franconia. He was put to death in 689 with Kolonat and Totnan. There is a very strong devotion to him in Wurzburg where his remains lie and also through the Bavarian countryside.

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK Monday 3 July - St Thomas, Apostle is said to have preached the gospel in India where he was martyred. The faithful that led him to know Christ in his wounds also sent him to

the farthest places to preach Christ Tuesday 4 July - St Elizabeth of Portugal 1271-1336, of the House of Aragon, had an unhappy marriage with the

King of Portugal. She persevered in prayer and good works and as a widow lived in poverty as a Franciscan tertiary.

Wednesday 5 July - St Anthony Zaccaria, Priest - 1502-39, was a medical doctor before becoming a priest in Milan, he founded the Barnabites.

Thursday 6 July - St Maria Goretti, Virgin and Martyr 1890-1902, stabbed to death in defence of her virtue and St Moninne of Killeavy, Virgin was one of Ireland's early female saints. After instruction in the religious life, she founded a community, initially consisting of eight virgins and a widow with a baby, at Slieve Gullion, in what became County Armagh. They lived an eremitical life. She died in 517.
