

**Oil Stamp Saving Scheme:** St. Vincent de Paul have cards on which persons using oil heating can put stamps purchased at £5 at a time, and save up to fill their oil tanks. This scheme has been in use for some time.

The cards are at the Ozanam Centre on William Street. The stamps can be bought at the Centre and at several businesses around the town. These businesses will be posted on the back of the cards.

Many people already using this method of saving find them very helpful. These cards are accepted by the oil companies in town.
