James Apostles. St Philip asked to see and having seen he tells the good news to others. Formerly a disciple of John the Baptist he became a follower of Christ. St James - He converted many of the people of Jerusalem to the faith and was martyred in the year 62.

Thursday 4th May - St Conleth,

Bishop of Kildare. Believed to have come from the Wicklow area. While living as a hermit he was persuaded by Brigid to act as priest for her community in Kildare.

Friday 5th May - Blessed Edmund

Rice. Came from Callan, Co Kilkenny. After the death of his young wife he sold his possessions and dedicated his life to the education of the poor
