

New pastoral arrangement within St Paul's

Dear Parishioners

Deacon Kevin Devine has been carrying out his ministry in both of our Lurgan parishes since he was ordained in St Peter's Church in October 2013 and will be very familiar to congregations here in St Paul's. He has regularly participated in the Sunday liturgy in St Paul's Church over the past three years and has frequently delivered the Homily at Mass. From November onwards, Deacon Kevin will be assuming overall pastoral responsibility for that part of St Paul's Parish which Fr McConville had looked after before his recent move to Kilwarlin: that is the district running from Edward Street, through Shankill and along the Lough Road to where St Paul's Parish borders St Peter's. Deacon Kevin will be visiting those housebound parishioners who previously received Holy Communion at home from Fr McConville, beginning in November.
