- This is your prayer time, be creative and include additional elements that will bring you and your family solace.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen Lord Jesus, you said, 'I am the Light of the World'. As we light this candle, we ask that your light will shine on all those who have died. May they be bathed always in the light of your love and grace and come to eternal life with you.

The candle is now lit. We call to mind all those who have gone before us. As we read aloud each of the names of our deceased relatives and friends let us give thanks for their lives in the stillness and guiet of our own hearts.
