

### Dromore Diocesan Historical Society Sunday, 17th June.

Field-trip to the elevated farm of Colin & Anne McMahon, Charlestown Rd, Derrytagh South, in the Derrytrasna district, six miles north of Lurgan, and near to the River Bann.

The farm overlooks Lough Gullion, once a lake 300 acres in extent which Charles Brownlow, later Lord Lurgan, successfully but temporarily drained in the period, 1828 - 33. The fieldtrip will be led by Frank McCorry who will firstly address the important recent discovery of a hidden and forgotten burial ground closeby, and secondly will provide a detailed account of the major early 19th century engineering project promoted by Brownlow whose aim was to secure 300 acres of new fertile ground. The project was planned by a top Scottish engineer, Alexander Nimmo, and worked by a team of 300 to 400 local labourers paid at one shilling per day. The farm is approached by a very long, narrow, ascending, well-surfaced lane or avenue, the Engine Rampart. There is parking for 30 cars in the farmyard. There can be **NO** parking in the lane. For the talk to begin at 2.30 pm parishioners should begin to arrive just after 2 pm. Might you have a folding-chair to give you comfort? If the weather proves unsuitable for an outdoor event, the talk will be switched by kind invitation to the nearby Sarsfields Community Hall. In any event, refreshments will be provided in Sarsfields Hall where a special and desirable memento of the event will be distributed at the conclusion of the afternoon. Parishioners most welcome.
