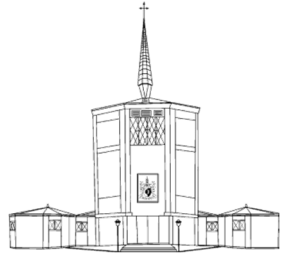

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

**Sunday 3 November: St Malachy, Bishop of
Armagh** - born near Armagh in 1094. He became
Vicar of Ceallach, the reforming Bishop of Armagh. He
continued this work of reform as Bishop of Connor and
later Bishop of Armagh. In 1148 Malachy set out from
Ireland to meet the Pope but died on his way at
Clairvaux, he is buried in the abbey church there.

**Monday 4 November - St Charles Borromeo,
Bishop** Cardinal Archbishop of Milan at the age of
twenty-one, worked for reform in his diocese. He is the
Patron saint of catechists and seminarians.

**Tuesday 5 November : Saint Martin DePorres
1579-1639.** He became a Dominican lay brother,
spending his nights in prayer and penance, his days in
the monastery, caring for the sick and poor. He is
renowned for his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.

Wednesday 6th November All the Saints of Ireland -
In the communion of Saints, many and varied
spiritualities have been developed throughout the
history of the Churches...The different schools of
Christian spirituality share in the living tradition of
prayer and are essential guides for the faithful. In their
rich diversity they are refractions of the one pure light
of the Holy Spirit.

**Thursday 7th November - St Willibrord, Bishop and
Missionary** - born in 658 in Northumbria. He entered
the Benedictine order. He spent 12 years at the
monastery of Rath Melsigi near Milford, Co Carlow.

GRAVEYARD POLICY

As available space becomes a premium in St Colman's cemetery the following
decision(s) has/have been taken to 'protect' what burial space there is
available for those who live in the parishes of St Peter and St Paul, Lurgan.

- From January 2025 the price of a single grave plot will be £325
- From January 2025 the price of a double grave plot will be £850 (and
these will only be granted in extreme circumstances as decided by the
Parish Finance Council). No grave plots will be able to be 'prior bought'.
They will only be available as and when required.
- Families/individuals who do not live in either of the parishes of St Peter's
or St Paul's, but have previously purchased burial plots (and have proof
of purchase) may be interred in St Colman's Cemetery.
- No new burial plots will be sold to people from outside the parish for burial
in St Colman's cemetery (even if they have prior connections with the
parish e.g. baptised, confirmed, married or through family ties).
- If any issues arise, with regard to the cemeteries, the final decision will
rest with the Parish Priest.

As agreed by the Finance Councils' of St Peter's and St Paul's parishes.
