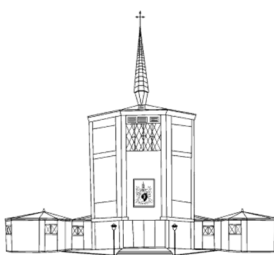

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 5th June - St Boniface, Bishop and Martyr, was born at Credition in Devonshire and educated in monastery schools in England. He founded monasteries in Bavaria.

Tuesday 6 June - St Norbert an St Jarlath, Bishops - St Norbert was the founder of the Norbertine Canons. St Jarlath, is said to be a disciple of St Enda. He became abbot bishop of the monastery he founded at Tuam in the 6th century.

Wednesday 7 June St Colman, Bishop - of Dromore Co Down and spent most of his life in that area.

Friday 9 June St Columba, Derry and Raphoe - also known as Colum Cille born in Gartan Co Donegal. He was noted for his great love for people and all living creatures.

Saturday 10 June - St Ephrem deacon and doctor of the Church - A native of Nisbis. He wrote commentaries on scripture and several hymns, later included in the liturgy. He encouraged devotion to Our Lady. Saturday Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

FIRST CLASS RELIC OF BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS, TO VISIT ST PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL, IN THIS THE 150TH YEAR SINCE THE DEDICATION OF THE CATHEDRAL

A first-class relic of Blessed Carlo will visit the Cathedral from Sunday 11 - Tuesday 13 June 2023. Blessed Carlo was beatified by Pope Francis in Assisi in October 2020. His friends remember him as a young dreamer, service-oriented and full of charisma. He died in 2006, at only 15 years of age, after a battle with leukaemia. His life may have been short but it made a huge impact. Recently, in the process for the teenager's beatification, his tomb became a real pilgrimage site.
