FIRST CLASS RELIC OF BLESSED **CARLO ACUTIS. TO VISIT ST** PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL, IN THIS THE **150TH YEAR SINCE THE DEDICATION** OF THE CATHEDRAL

A first-class relic of Blessed Carlo will visit the Cathedral from Sunday 11 - Tuesday 13 June 2023. Blessed Carlo was beatified by Pope Francis in Assisi in October 2020. His friends remember him as a young dreamer, service-oriented and full of charisma. He died in 2006, at only 15 years of age, after a battle with leukaemia. His life may have been short but it made a huge impact. Recently, in the process for the teenager's beatification, his tomb became a real pilgrimage site.
