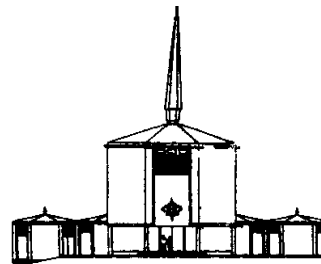


Lourdes Procession
