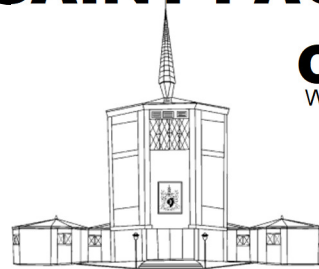

OUR CHURCHES HAVE REOPENED

Our Churches reopened on **Monday 29th June** in line with local government guidelines and the Framework Document approved by the Irish Episcopal Conference.

It is most important that people who are vulnerable or unwell, and especially those with any symptoms that might suggest Covid-19 infection, should stay at home and, if possible, participate, as now, via webcam, or radio. The same applies to those who have been in recent contact with someone who has the virus, in accordance with public health advice.

See our revised Mass schedule, which is also available via the webcam.

St. Paul's Church Schedule

- Weekday Masses – (Monday – Friday) – 10am
- Saturday Mass - 10.30am
- Sunday Masses - 7pm (vigil), 9am and 10.30am

St. Peter's Church Schedule

- Weekday Masses – (Monday – Friday) – 8am, (Tuesday and Friday) - 7.00pm
- Saturday Mass - 9.30am
- Sunday Masses - 6pm (Vigil), 8am and 10.00am (Polish) and 12.15pm

The 2-metre social distancing rule means that our church can only accommodate a capacity of approx. 60 people.

We wish to remind parishioners that the dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation is extended at this time, but for those wishing to attend Mass we have introduced a temporary rota over a 3 week cycle for Sunday Mass and vigil mass to ensure parishioners that wish to attend Mass will have the opportunity to do so, (subject to capacity guidelines):

- **Week 1 - Taghnaven area** – 4th & 5th July
- **Week 2 - Shankill area** – 11th & 12th July
- **Week 3 - All other areas** – 18th & 19th July

Weekday masses are open on a first come first service basis and not restricted by area. This will be reviewed regularly and revised as necessary.

We have also introduced several measures for the safety of our Parishioners:

- The church opening hours will be daily from 11.00am - 6.00pm
- The church will open approx. 20 minutes before each mass to allow for cleaning in advance of Mass commencing and entry will be prohibited 5 minutes before Mass begins.
- The Church doors will be closed during cleaning periods.
- Ushers will greet you to the church and assign you a seat, we ask that you co-operate with the ushers in this regard.
- The holy water fonts will not be in use.
- Hand sanitisers are provided at the back of the Church and we ask you to use them on entry and exit to the Church.
- A one-way system is in operation with markings on the floor.
- Pews are marked clearly to allow for social distancing.
- Families from the same household may sit together.
- You are invited to make an offering at the entrance as baskets will not be passed during Masses.
- The pews are disinfected daily and after every mass.
- Candle Room will remain closed
- Toilet facilities will remain closed.

Please note that the timetable and precautions will be reviewed regularly in line with updated advice. To answer any queries contact the parish offices at 028 3832 1289, 028 3832 3161 or Father Colum at 028 3832 7173.
