Introducing ‘Morning Prayer’ at St. Paul’s
Morning Prayer of the Church, from the *Divine Office*, will be prayed publicly in St. Paul’s Church at **9.40 am**, on **Monday** and **Wednesday** mornings, beginning **Monday, 13th June**.
This form of prayer, which is approximately ten minutes in length, will be recited in advance of the daily Mass on those days. The *Divine Office*, otherwise known as the *Liturgy of the Hours*, is the official daily prayer of the Church. It has a fixed structure and specific texts for each day. Various parts of the *Divine Office* (Morning, Midday, Evening & Night Prayer) were recited publicly in St. Paul’s during the 24 Hours for the Lord, in early March.
A number of parishioners asked that consideration be given to continuing this form of prayer on a more regular basis and the Parish Pastoral Council has been reflecting upon this since then. Books containing the texts for Morning Prayer have been purchased by the Parish and will be available for use by parishioners on Monday and Wednesday mornings.
More information on the content and structure of Morning Prayer will be included in next week’s bulletin.

A special event based on the wonderful biography, *‘Two Brothers: Two Wars’*, written by Professor Tom McAlindon, recounting in detail the lives of his two uncles, Captain Tom McAlindon and Fr.D. McAlindon, Vicar General, Maynooth Mission to China.
Tom died a young man, in 1918, of wounds received towards the end of World War I, and is interred in St. Mary’s, Derrytrasna. Fr. Denis, a heroic missionary in Burma during World War II, died in January ’93, and is buried in Dalgan Park, Co. Meath.
Teresa Nelson and Henry McCorry will consider the life of Tom, and Joan Aldridge and Frank McCorry will reflect on the missionary zeal and fortitude of Fr. Denis. Everyone welcome.
