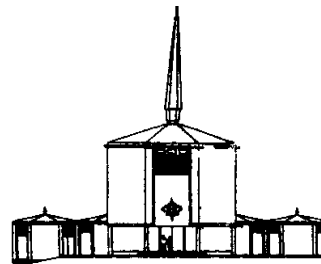

were made to free the lorry.

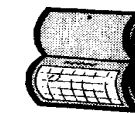
A few school kids were sitting on a wall nearby,
