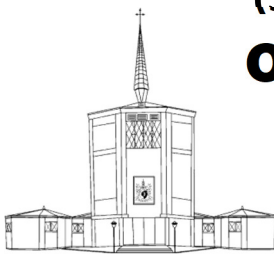
PILGRIMAGE TO KNOCK SHRINE FOR PARENTS

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 6th November All the Saints of Ireland - In the communion of Saints, many and varied spiritualities have been developed throughout the history of the Churches...The different schools of Christian spirituality share in the living tradition of prayer and are essential guides for the faithful. In their rich diversity they are refractions of the one pure light of the Holy Spirit.
Tuesday 7th November - St Willibrord, Bishop and Missionary - born in 658 in Northumbria. He entered the Benedictine order. He spent 12 years at the monastery of Rath Melsigi near Milford, Co Carlow.

Thursday 9th November: The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica - The Church of St John on the Lateran in Rome is 'Mother and Head of all the churches of the City and the World'. It is the cathedral church of the Bishop of Rome and was called 'St John' after the two monasteries once attached, dedicated to St John the Divine and St John the Baptist. It is however, dedicated to the Most Holy Saviour.

Friday 10th November: St Leo the Great, pope and doctor of the Church- elected Bishop of Rome 440, died 461, taught the two natures, human and divine, of Christ at the Council of Chalcedon, 451 and the primacy of the See of

Saturday 11th November - St Martin of Tours, Bishop - 316-97, Bishop of Tours, apostle of rural Gaul, founder of monasteries. Patron of France, soldiers, beggars and innkeepers.

THE DIOCESE OF DROMORE has published the Report of the Second Review of
Child Safeguarding Practice in the Diocese undertaken by the National Board for
Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland at the invitation of
Archbishop Eamon Martin, Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese.

The Review process, which began in March 2023, assessed compliance with
Safeguarding Children Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland,
2016. The Reviewers also looked at governance arrangements in the Diocese and
any opportunities for learning and development.

In response to the report Archbishop Martin said *"we are very much aware of the
terrible wrong done to innocent children in the past and we are doing everything in
our power to prevent anything like that happening again. I encourage everyone to
read the Review report in full and to be vigilant to ensure that the Diocese remains
fully committed to safeguarding today and in the future."*

SAFEGUARDING SURVEY FOR SURVIVORS OF ABUSE

The Irish Bishops' Conference, along with the Association of Leaders of Missionaries
and Religious of Ireland, have commissioned consultants, RSM Ireland, to undertake a
review of child safeguarding in the Catholic Church.

One part of this review is to engage with survivors and victims of abuse, to seek their
views on Church Safeguarding processes. Specifically, RSM would like to hear from
survivors who have disclosed abuse within the last twenty years, to see what needs to
be improved.
