

#### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Faith is not measured by its size but by its surrender. When the disciples pleaded, 'increase our faith! Jesus replied that even faith as small as a mustard seed could uproot mountains (v. 6).

Yet true faith is not about spectacular displays - it's about humble obedience. 'When you have done all you were commanded, say, 'We are unworthy servants" (v.

God doesn't demand grand achievements but faithful steps. Today, trust Him with what little faith you have, and let obedience - not applause - be your motive. The smallest seed of faith, planted in surrender, moves heaven's hand.
