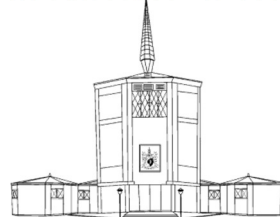

### FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

**Monday 8th July - St Kilian, Bishop and Martyr** According to Irish sources, St Kilian was born in the parish of Mullagh in the diocese of Kilmore. With eleven companions, he left Ireland and became known as the apostle of Thuringia and eastern Franconia. With Kolonat and Totnan he was put to death in 689. There is a very strong devotion to him in Würzburg, where his remains lie, devotion is very strong throughout the Bavaria countryside.

**Tuesday 9th July - Ss Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest and companions, martyrs** St Augustine Tchao born 1746, converted to Christianity was ordained priest and martyred in 1815. The memorial also celebrates 119 companions, martyred in China over several centuries but especially during the Boxer Uprising.

**Thursday 11 July - St Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe** after living as a hermit at Subiaco, founded the monastery of Monte Cassino. His Rule, observed by Benedictines and Cistercians is distinguished by its wisdom and balance and those who lived by it did much to shape the Europe of today. Named patron of Europe in 1964.

**Saturday 13 July - St Henry 973-1024**, Duke of Bavaria and later emperor. A just ruler, humble man of prayer and reformer of the Church.
