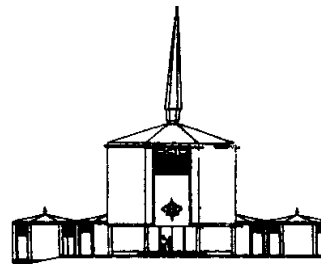

We celebrate in the Church, this year, the Centenary of the Apparitions of The Blessed Virgin Mary to the three shepherd children of Fatima.

Dromore Diocesan Historical Society

Monday, 15th May, 7 pm

An historical outing to Dromore, Co. Down organised by Fr. Andrew McMahon, and meeting within the Church of Ireland Cathedral on the bank of the River Lagan for a guided tour in the precincts of the Cathedral.

The outing will embrace the religious, historical and inter-community legacy in this ancient place. Nearby, a composite high cross stands guard on the Lagan bridge. St. Colman's pillow, a hallowed, carved and decorated stone, is retained within the Cathedral. Parishioners are most welcome at this ground-breaking event.

The Cathedral is located at the 3-way roundabout where the Lurgan and Banbridge Roads join the entrance to the town centre. There is a car-park 100 yards from the Cathedral, opposite the entrance to the Ulster Bank, on the narrow road that joins the Cathedral to the town centre.
