TROCAIRE EASTER COLLECTION 2022



This year the UK government will match all Trocaire donations received before 1st June 2022 to the Lenten Appeal in Northern Ireland pound for pound up to £2 million, helping thousands of people in Zimbabwe.

Last year 2021, the donations from the Diocese of Dromore amounted to £141,590.00 and this amount was matched under the UK government Matched funding scheme.

This was a great amount donated by parishioners considering our churches and schools were in lock down during lent 2021. It is my hope that Diocese will have collected an amount similar to last year but it would be a great achievement if this was exceeded in 2022.

The parishioners of the Diocese of Dromore have always been exceptionally generous in their donations to Trocaire over the years.
