FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 9 October - St John Henry

Newman, Priest John Henry Newman was canonized on October 13 2019 by Pope Francis after a second miracle was attributed to him. The Church in Ireland is deeply aware of St John Henry's gentle scholarship, deep human wisdom and profound love for the Lord.

St John Leonardie, supported the reforms to Trent, published a Catechism and helped to found the Propagation of the Faith in Rome.

Wednesday 11 October - St Pope John

XXIII, was head of the Catholic Church and sovereign of the Vatican City State from 28 October 1958 until his death in June 1963. He was born on 25 November 1881 in Sotto il Monte, Italy. He died 3 June 1963 at the Apostolic Palace, Vatican

St Canice, - born in Co Derry around 527 and died in **603**. Though his people were poor, he studied at Clonard under Finnian and at Glasnevin under Mobhi A deep friendship developed between himself and Columba with whom he worked for a time in Scotland. where he set up a number of churches. In Ireland his principal foundation was in Aghaboe in Ossory but this was replaced centuries later by his Church in Kilkenny Saturday 14 October - St Callistus I, pope and martyr after a life of slavery and imprisonment for criminal offences, was freed and became a deacon in charge of catacombs that bear his names. He became Pope in 217, opposed by Hippolytus. Died at the hands of a
