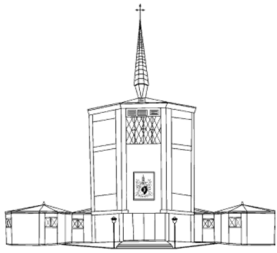

Due to the unavailability of priests in St Peter's and St Paul's parishes during July, a decision, has regretfully been made, to discontinue the Friday evening Mass at 7.00pm in St Peter's. Instead of Mass our permanent deacon Rev Kevin Devine, will lead a Eucharistic Service, at which Holy Communion will be offered. These changes will take effect from Friday 30th June.

If you're visiting a country not mentioned above, please bring us back a cross or a Christian symbol for our exhibition. We'd like to know where else the message of Christ is being proclaimed.

BAPTISMS

CHOOSING GODPARENTS

Congratulations to all the parents of newborn children in our parish. With your baby's best interests at heart, the Church asks you when considering sponsors for your child's baptism to choose a godfather and godmother (one male, one female) who are at least 16 years old and who lead a life of faith. One of the sponsors (called a 'witness') may be a baptized Christian from another church.

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Tuesday 11 July - St Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe after living as a hermit at Subiaco, found the monastery of Monte Cassino. His Rule, observed by Benedictines and Cistercians is distinguished by its wisdom and balance and those who lived by it did much to shape the Europe of today. Named patron of Europe in 1964.
Thursday 13 July - St Henry 973-1024, Duke of Bavaria and later emperor. A just ruler, humble man of prayer and reformer of the Church.

Friday 14 July - St Camillus de Lellis, 1550-1614, rough-tempered and a gambler in his early life as a soldier, he was converted at the age of twenty-five. Guided by St Philip Nerie, he became a priest and worked for the sick with two companions. His Servants of the Sick prospered and funded hospitals especially where others would not go. Patron of nurses, hospitals and the sick.

Saturday 15 July - St Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church born in Tuscan (1221-74) Minister General of the Franciscans, Cardinal Archbishop of Albano, theologian of the Council of Lyon.
