FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK Monday 11 August 2025 – St Clare,

Virgin: born at Assisi in 1193, died 1253. She followed St Francis in his life of poverty and was founder and ruler of the Poor Clares. She led an austere life, abounding in works of piety and charity. Patron of television.

Tuesday 12 August – St Jane Frances

deChantal married at age 20 left a widow with four children after 9 years. Her friendship with St Francis deSales led to the foundation of the Congregation of the Visitation.

Wednesday 13 August – St Fachtna: died around 600. His monastery became the

principal monastery of west Cork and later had a famous scripture school.

Thursday 14 August - St Maximilian Kolbe

Thursday 14 August - St Maximilian Kolbe, priest and martyr - a Conventual Franciscan who worked in the apostolate of the press in Poland and Japan, and died in Auschwitz.

Friday 15 August - The Assumption of

Mary honours the fullness of blessedness that was her destiny, the glorification of her immaculate soul and virginal body that completely conformed her to the risen Christ. This is a celebration that offers to the Church and to all humanity an exemplar and a consoling message, teaching us the fulfilment of our highest hones

Saturday 16th August - St Stephen of Hungary 975-1038, first king of Hungary and its patron saint, worked for the conversion of his people to Christianity
