Two illustrated A4 booklets, the start of a series related to local and regional history compiled by Frank McCorry will be launched at 2.00pm – 4.30pm on Saturday afternoon June 18th in St Peter's Parish Hall, North Street Lurgan. The author's address relating to the booklets' themes will begin at 2.30pm (for 30 minutes). A cup of tea will follow. Anti-Covid masks are encouraged.
Booklets 1 (28 pages £5.00) has two sections:
1. Shankill Parish (Lurgan) Church of Ireland Vestry, 1672-1782, combined district administration and colonist community formation.
2. A Portrait of Shankill Graveyard Lurgan a pre-Reformation and post Plantation church-site, now a tranquil shared place of burial.
Booklet II (40 pages, £5.00) has three sections
1. Prelude: Seven ancestral memories: Hidden gems supplied by people who solely held valuable local history narratives.
2. The Early Christian and Medieval Church flourished in south Co Antrim and East Co Down, 28 sites.
3. Affirmation of 8th century Egyptian Monks in Dundesert Monastery, near Crumlin Co Antrim. Each booklet places new and valid material into the public domain.
