#### ALL SAINTS - 1<sup>st</sup> November

Today's liturgy invites us: 'Let us all rejoice in the Lord'. The saints are too numerous to count. They include all the canonised saints - but they also number *all* the gracious people of goodness from every tribe, tongue, nation and epoch who reflects God's love faithfully. They touched and enriched our lives with love, forgiveness, laughter, humour and countless 'unremembered acts of kindness.'

ALL SOULS - 2<sup>nd</sup> November The word ALL is small. It includes everyone. No-one is outside the unconditional mercy and love of God. The prayers from the Masses are consoling and reassuring: 'Listen kindly to our prayers, O Lord', 'look mercifully', may they pass over to a dwelling of light and peace', may they receive the joy of eternal happiness'.

At this present time we have the capacity to accommodate 80 people within our Church. The following measures have been introduced for all our safety.

- Ushers will greet you at the church entrance and assign you a seat.
- Hand sanitisers are provided. It is necessary to use them at all times. • You are invited to make an offering at the entrance to the Church - there is a basket for offertory envelopes and donations can be given. Naturally, in the interest of safety collection baskets will not be passed around.
- Offertory envelopes and donations can also be left into the sacristy with Noel, or at the Parish Office
- At present holy water fonts are not in use.
- A one-way system is in operation with clear markings on the walls.
- All seats/pews are marked clearly to allow for social distancing.
- Families from the same household can sit together.
- To avoid the passing of speech droplets, there will be no congregational singing.
- The Eucharist is to be received at all times on our hands.
- Please note that all seats/pews are disinfected daily and after each Mass.
- Unfortunately, our toilet facilities have to remain closed.

It is mandatory to use face coverings at all Masses and other liturgical celebrations, eg Weddings, Funerals & Baptisms along with the on-going maintenance of 2 metre physical distancing with immediate effect.

We apologise for the inconvenience and disruption that these changes bring about for all of us - but be aware that they have been introduced in line with government advice as very necessary measures to ensure our utmost safety and wellbeing. Should any parishioner be diagnosed with Covid-19 it is imperative that we are notified immediately! Simply contact our Parish Office, our Sacristan or one of our Priests!

The Executive has issued new guidance in relation to weddings and funerals restricting the number to 25 at both these occasions. There are to be no pre or post funeral gatherings and no wedding receptions. Only Parents, Godparents & babies are permitted at Baptisms. (Siblings may attend if living in the same household)

The wearing of face coverings at all Masses and liturgical ceremonies is now MANDATORY.
