Lisieux*

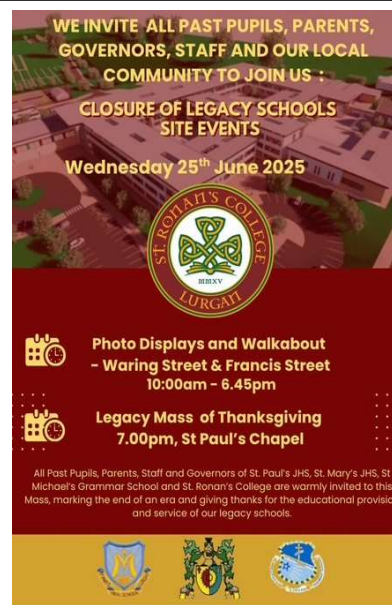
O Jesus, eternal Priest, keep your
