We are all delighted to welcome our parishioners back again for community worship in St Peter's.

A joint meeting of the St Peter's Pastoral Council and the Knights of St Columbanus was held on Tuesday 23rd March. Advice from the Archbishop was noted, and the following was decided:

- 1. (a) Extra stewards for the Masses on Palm Sunday and the Masses of the sacred  $\mbox{Triduum}.$
- (b) When the capacity of the Church is reached following social distancing rules the doors will be closed.
- 2. <u>Palm Sunday</u> Palms will be available to be collected as you come into Mass. Masses as usual 6.00pm, 8.00am, 10.00am (po polsku) & 12.00 noon
- 3. Holy Thursday Mass @ 6.00pm.
  - (a) No washing of feet.
  - (b)No procession to the altar of repose.
- (c) No late Holy Hour.

### 4. Good Friday

- (a) Stations of the Cross @ 3.00pm Virtual (Power Point)
- (b) Polish Stations of the Cross 6.00pm (Virtual)
- (c) Solemn Liturgy with Holy Communion 7.00pm

Only the priest is permitted to kiss the cross on the altar.

Parishioners may like to bring their rosary beads or a small crucifix to kiss their own cross in their seats.

### Holy Saturday

- (a) The evening vigil Mass 9.00pm
- (b)Masses on Easter Sunday 6.00am (po polsku), 8.00am, 10.00am,

### 11.00am (po polsku) & 12.15pm

Notice we are back to the old Sunday schedule. <u>This is only for Easter Sunday and will allow more people to attend Mass.</u>

(c) On arrival at the Church, please collect a bottle of blessed holy water (prepared by the Knights of St Columbanus). At the 10.00 and 11.00 Masses please leave the Church by the side doors at the front. This is to avoid those queuing for the later Masses.

### 6. Distribution of Holy Communion

- (a) Those in the transepts to come first.
- (b) Those in the main body of the Church to come up the centre aisle and return by the side aisles.
- (c) Stewards will direct.
- 7. Please always obey the direction of the stewards.
