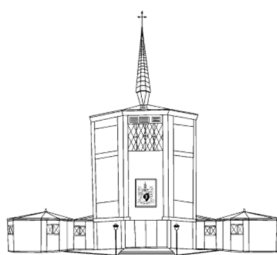

PUBLIC LECTURE BY DR FRANCIS MCCORRY

On Saturday evening 16th October Lurgan's pre-eminent historian Dr Francis X. McCorry will be providing a local history talk entitled:

**Shankill Parish (Lurgan) Church of Ireland Vestry, 1672-1782:
 District Administration and Community Building**

In this lecture, organised by the Lurgan Townscape Heritage scheme, Dr McCorry will examine the early history of the Shankill Parish Church Vestry between the years 1672 and 1782. Insights will be provided on the formation of the Vestry, the personalities involved and the great influence which the body exercised on the overall administration, development and welfare of the young town of Lurgan in what were challenging years marked by increasing poverty and periodic outbreaks of disease and famine in the town.

The lecture will be held on **Saturday 16th October** in the Jethro Centre (Flush Place, Lurgan).
