



THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Ten lepers were healed, but only one returned to give thanks - a Samaritan, an outsider. Jesus asked 'Where are the other nine? (v. 17).

Gratitude is the bridge between receiving God's gifts and truly knowing Him. The thankful leper was made well' (v. 19) - whole in body and soul.

Miracles awaken faith, but thanksgiving deepens it. Today, count your blessings and voice your praise. Like the Samaritan, don't just enjoy God's mercy return to Him with a grateful heart. For when thanks is scarce, joy fades; but where thanks overflows, faith flourishes.
