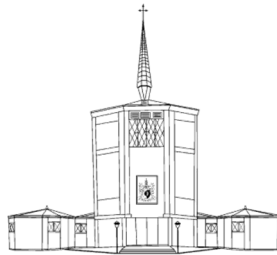

FREE SUPPORT SERVICE TO HELP PEOPLE WITH THEIR HEARING AIDS RETURNS TO LURGAN.

The next session is taking place on Tuesday 22nd July, from 10am to 12noon. It will be held at the Lurgan Library 1 Carnegie St, Lurgan BT66 6AS
The service is provided by the RNID.
"We can provide new batteries, cleaning and retubing of ear moulds and open fits for NHS hearing aids," the charity explained.
"Hearing aids must be placed in a labelled envelope, with name and contact details," the charity added.
"We can also offer basic hearing checks for those who don't already wear hearing aids".
"Users can wait for the service to be done at Lurgan Library or drop off your hearing aids to RNID and return before 12noon to collect hearing aids."
Hearing aids can be dropped off by friends or family members.

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 14th July – St Camillus de Lellis, Priest 1559-1614, rough-tempered and a gambler in his early life as a soldier, he was converted at the age of twenty-five. Guided by St Philip Neri, he became a priest and worked for the sick with two companions. His Servants of the Sick prospered and found hospitals especially where others would not go. Patron of nurses, hospitals and the sick.
Tuesday 15th July – St Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church born in Tuscan (1221-74) Minister General of the Franciscans, Cardinal Archbishop of Albano, theologian of the Council of Lyon.

Wednesday 16th July – Our Lady of Mount Carmel Ss Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest and companions, martyrs
St Augustine Tchao born 1746, converted to Christianity was ordained priest and martyred in 1815. The memorial also celebrates 119 companions, martyred in China over several centuries but especially during the Boxer Uprising.
