FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 15th July - St Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church born in Tuscan (1221-74) Minister General of the Franciscans, Cardinal Archbishop of Albano, theologian of the Council of Lyon.

Tuesday 16th July - Our Lady of Mount Carmel Ss Augustine Zhao Rong, Priest and companions, martyrs
St Augustine Tchao born 1746, converted to Christianity was ordained priest and martyred in 1815. The memorial also celebrates 119 companions, martyred in China over several centuries but especially during the Boxer Uprising.

Thursday 11 July - St Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe after living as a hermit at Subiaco, found the monastery of Monte Cassino. His Rule, observed by Benedictines and Cistercians is distinguished by its wisdom and balance and those who lived by it did much to shape the Europe of today. Named patron of Europe in 1964.

Saturday 13 July - St Henry 973-1024, Duke of Bavaria and later emperor. A just ruler, humble man of prayer and reformer of the Church.
