Siena, priest - born in 1380, as a young man he took charge of a hospital in Siena during a plague. Then he became a Franciscan, travelled through Italy preaching with great success. He promoted devotion to the Holy Name and St Joseph.

Wednesday 21 Ss Christopher Magallánes and Companions. These twenty-five priest and laymen were executed in 1927 in Mexico.

Thursday 22 May - St Rita of Cascia

Known as the 'Patron Saint of Impossible Causes.' is revered for her deep faith, perseverance, and miraculous intercessions. She lived in the 14th and 15th centuries and is often invoked for her ability to bring hope in seemingly hopeless situations.

'There is nothing impossible to God. There is no problem, no matter how difficult it is, that we cannot resolve by the power of God.

'If you desire to be loved, love. If you desire to be forgiven, forgive. If you desire to be understood,
