The Knights of St Columbanus

The Knights of St Columbanus will be distributing **St Brigid's Crosses** at all the masses (including the Vigil) on (26th January) the Sunday before Ireland's patroness's feast - St Brigid's day 1st February. Voluntary donations will be appreciated. Last year the funds raised were used to provide a defibrillator for the church.

All funds raised will go towards our major project for this year which will be the building of a Shrine to Our Lady of Lourdes in the grounds of St Paul's church. Our plans are well advanced with the support and guidance of a local architect and specialist builder. The estimated cost will be between £8,000 and £10,000. The Knights of St Columbanus have already raised 20% of these funds to date themselves. A number of fundraising events will be forthcoming this year.

We will update parishioners fully about the progress of this project regularly through this bulletin.

The Knights of St Columbanus have been in existence in Lurgan, since 1920. We are proud to be an Order of Catholic Laymen committed to supporting our Catholic faith and to do good works in a spirit of fraternity and Christian charity. In the past we have supported the establishment of the Catholic Scout movement, the Credit Union in Ireland as well as the John Paul II Awards and also making a major contribution to the organisation of the World Meeting of Families in Dublin. We were honoured to have organised the adoration of the relics of St Therese of Lisieux and St Teresa of Calcutta in recent years. We continue to support all our local schools through the annual distribution of children's prayers booklets to all First Holy Communicants. The Knights continue to support youth pilgrimages and retreats, as well as the parish radio and web services in the Deanery and of course the annual distribution of Easter Holy Water. We have also supported overseas parish development projects in Central America and Asia.
