Please see below the instructions for downloading the latest version of our Parish App by going directly to the App Store or Google Play Store.

1. Open the App Store on your Apple device or the Play Store on your Android device. In the search bar, type Parish365 Look out for this icon (right) in the search results. Press Get or Install.
2. Open the app and connect to our parish by clicking the + button. Enter the town name when prompted - Lurgan. Click 'Continue' to see St Peter's and St Paul's. Tick here and click the Save icon in top right corner.
3. Choose your Profile to receive notifications on your device. Tick the option box for St Peter's Parishioner and/or St Paul's Parishioner and any other areas of interest eg Funeral Information Then click the save icon in top right corner.  
When asked if you wish to allow Notifications, click 'Yes' or 'Allow'.
