EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION



While the Churches remain closed we are pleased to offer adoration online from your homes through the webcams.

REGINA COELI

During Eastertide it is traditional to replace the Angelus prayer at 12noon and 6pm with the *Regina Coeli*. This prayer honours Our Lady as Mother of the Risen Lord:

Rejoice, Queen of Heaven, alleluia!
For he whom it was your privilege to bear, alleluia!
Has risen as he said, alleluia!
Pray for us to God, alleluia!
Rejoice and be glad, Virgin Mary, alleluia!
For the Lord is truly risen, alleluia!
Let us pray.

O God, who by the Resurrection of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, have been pleased to gladden the whole world, grant we beseech you, that through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may attain the joys of eternal life.
Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.
