FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Tuesday 11th October: - St Canice, Abbot Was born in Derry around 527 and died in 603. He set up a number of churches. In Ireland his principal foundation was in Aghaboe in Ossory, but this was replaced centuries later by his church in Kilkenny.

Also St John XXIII pope. He worked as a military chaplain in World War 1. He was elected Pope on 28 October 1958. He called the Second Vatican Council which began on 11 Octover 1962. Pope John XXIII died on 3 June 1963

Friday 14th October: - St Callistus 1, pope and martyr after a life of slavery and imprisonment for criminal offences, was freed and became a deacon in charge of catacombs that bear his name. He became pope in 217,

Saturday 15th October: - St Teresa of Avila, virgin and doctor of the Church.

1515-82, deeply contemplative, highly active and practical, she established Carmelite convents under a reformed rule and wrote much about prayer and the spiritual life. St Teresa is patron of lacemakers and headache suffers.
